





***estimates of Inuit payroll expenditures shall be limited to the minimum requirement set out by the Contract Authority; and,”***

**Clarification:** Only the Inuit bid adjustment for estimates of Inuit payroll expenditures shall be limited to the minimum requirement set out by the Contract Authority. Estimates of Inuit payroll expenditures above the minimum requirement set out by the Contract Authority will be entitled to receive applicable Local or Nunavut Resident adjustment on the amounts exceeding the minimum requirements.

**11.1.(g) “Where no local business submits a Bid or Proposal and only one of the Bidders or Proponents qualifies for the Nunavut Business status adjustment, the qualifying Nunavut Business shall be deemed to be a Local Business and the Local Business status adjustment shall apply”**

**Clarification:**

Section 11.1(g) is suspended and not to be applied pending further consultation with NTI on wording that would provide access for Inuit Firms listed on the NTI Inuit Firm Registry.

**11.3 “Tenders and RFPs by invitation may be issued exclusively to Nunavut based businesses where sufficient competition exists, being three (3) or more companies located in Nunavut that are interested and capable of performing the work. The GN may also invite Inuit firms that are not based in Nunavut, provided they are included on the NTI Inuit Firms Registry.”**

**Clarification:**

By definition, the wording of Section 11.3 makes Section 11.3 a Restricted Invitational Tendering process by inviting Nunavut based businesses only. As such, it should only be used for Tenders of goods or services and Requests For Proposals valued under \$25,000.
